

The order of adverbs typically follows this structure, known as the Manner, Place, Frequency, Time, and Purpose (MPFTP) order:

1. Manner (how?): quickly, slowly, happily

2. Place (where?): here, there, everywhere

3. Frequency (how often?): often, rarely, always

4. Time (when?): now, soon, yesterday

5. Purpose (why?): to improve, for fun, in order to win

Example sentence:

She danced gracefully (manner) in the park (place) every day (frequency) at sunset (time) to relax (purpose).

However, not all sentences will include every type of adverb, and their placement can vary depending on emphasis and sentence structure.
