

## To + Gerund

Is it possible to use "to" followed by the -ing form?  
القاعدة تقول بأن تتنبئ بالفعل أي فعل بدون أي إيمانات -  
ing ed, -s base form

"There is an exception to  
Every rule"

### Rule exceptions:

- particular phrasal verbs require an -ing verb form after to. (gerund : verb -ing form which functions as nouns)

1. Look forward to ; ينطلق إلى

Think about something that going to happen.

#### Example:-

I look forward to meeting you.

2. feel up to : لديه القوه على / لديه القدرة على

لديه القدرة على

To have the strength or energy to deal or do something.

#### Example:-

I don't feel up to going out tonight.

3. get round/around to : يجد الفرصة / الوقت لفعل شيء

To find the time to do something or to deal with it.

(Something that you haven't done yet or dealt with)

#### Example:-

I haven't got around to writing my essay yet.

4. Take to : To start doing something often 'as a habit'

تعود على / موي / انتجه إلى او نخو

#### Example:-

- He has taken to eating healthy food.

- I have taken to flossing my teeth daily.

5. accustomed to : (adjective) familiar with something.  
المُعتَاد / المُتَّقِد

Example:

I'm accustomed to waking up early every morning.

6. used to : المُعتَاد / المُتَّقِد

Example:

He used to swimming early in the morning.

7. Adjust to : التَّكْوين / التَّكْوين

Example: How would you adjust to working for a new company?

8. Addicted to : المُنْجِد

Example: I'm addicted to watching T.V.

9. Confess / admit : يعترف بالـ / يقر بالـ

Example:

- He confessed to stealing the money.

- She won't admit to cheating on the test.

10. devoted to <sup>adj</sup> مُحْسِد / مُتَّهَب (noun)  
اللَّذَّانِي / الْمُهْسَدُونَ

Examples:

- She's devoted to helping the poor.

- I'm impressed by her devotion to helping the poor.

11. dedicated to <sup>adj</sup> مُؤْمِن / مُؤْمِن (noun)  
الْمُؤْمَنُونَ

Examples:

She's dedicated to helping the poor.

I'm impressed by her dedication to helping the poor.

12. Committed to <sup>adj</sup> مُؤْمِن / Commitment to <sup>noun</sup> إِيمَانٌ :

Examples: I'm committed to improving my work.

We talked about our commitment to improving our work.

13. Opposed to (by) Jai, law / opposition to Jai, law

## Examples:

I'm opposed to changing the laws.

There's a lot of opposition to changing the laws.

14. <sup>(v)</sup> object to / بمعنی مخالفت / objection to  
المخالفات

Examples: ..

- We object to allowing smoking inside the building.
  - I don't understand your objection to allowing smoking in the building.

15. be + used + to (extra examples)

accustomed

adjust

I'm not used to waking up early.

I'm accustomed to waking up early.

I might need to adjust to waking up early.
