Affirmative:

Subject+ have/has+ v.3 .

Negative:

Subject+ haven't /hasn't+v.3.

Interrogative:

Has/Have +subject+v.3?

Usage: to describe actions with present relevance .

To express experiences.

To convey actions that have just happened.

To discuss actions at in specified past time.

For instance: I have finished my work.

I've finished...

She has travelled to Europe.

She's got...

They have just arrived.

They 've ...

He has seen that movie.

He's seen....
